NOTIFICATION

It is noticed that a large number of complaints are being received by the Police from general public, IT employees through various media in recent days regarding the dangerous movement of certain heavy vehicles like trucks/tippers carrying rock boulders, debris and other construction related waste materials on important roads in city limits.

Many road accidents have taken place in recent times due to the dangerous/negligent driving of these vehicles loaded heavily with C&D wastes. Also, many times, the boulders are falling onto the roads, the loaded vehicles toppling causing serious threats to the other road users as it endangers human life. Further, these vehicles are moving dangerously amidst the already highly congested roads in the IT corridor and residential areas causing many road safety issues besides leading to congestion on roads. Many a times, these vehicles breakdown on high vehicular density roads resulting in unmanageable traffic congestion as the towing and recovery of these vehicles amidst the high volume traffic becomes highly difficult.

Moreover, movement of these vehicles with heavy loadings and C&D materials has resulted in a sense of insecurity among other road users in the core area of Cyberabad limits particularly among the motorcyclists, school going children, pedestrians. These heavily loaded vehicles are plying on main roads during peak hours also causing great inconvenience to the regular commuters on these roads.

Most importantly, these vehicles are found to be plying on roads without any safety measures viz., lack of back doors or improper backdoors; absence of number plates, absence of lights/indicators etc.

Though the Police are regularly taking action against such dangerous movement of these vehicles and also conducting regular awareness programmes to the owners and drivers, there have been no significant changes in their behaviour.

In this background, it is felt necessary to restrict the movement of such heavy vehicles loaded with C&D materials during day time on important roads in Cyberabad Metropolitan limits in view of public safety and traffic management.

Hence, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 7 Clause (1) of Cyberabad City Police Act r/w Section 21 Clause (1) (b) of Hyderabad City Police Act 1348-F, I, V.C. Sajjanar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad do here by notify for the information of general public, that the following restrictions are imposed as given below for certain categories of vehicles in certain critical areas under Cyberabad Metropolitan area:

Type of Vehicles:

Heavy motor vehicles carrying rock boulders and other C&D waste materials.

Restricted Time: Between 6 am and 10 pm.

Restricted area:

All roads in the limits of following PSs:

Madhapur

Gachibowli

Raidurgam

Miyapur


Chandanagar

KPHB

Kukatpally

Narsingi

The above restrictions will come into force from **01.08.2018** and those found violating the above restrictions will be liable for action under relevant sections of Cyberabad City Police Act, M.V. Act, IPC and other laws in force.
